C. Activities Report

• Team

As a team we meet every quarter either physically or via video conferencing came together. Besides that, there are additional activities such as writing reports, accounting, communicating with Madagascar and an active commitment to raise support for several projects in Madagascar. We also are investigating the possibilities of starting our own foundation in the Netherlands so we no longer have to contribute a fairly high amount of funds towards Jeugd Met Een Opdracht for administration.

- Training workers. We are training workers on the field how to work with budgets on the field, so that promoting projects and fundraising for them will be simpler.
- Raising funds. As team, we spent many hours raising funds and getting our communication lines clear with Madagascar. In addition to all of this we are working on unity and synergy between the two ministries above as a form of reconciliation after a difficult time in Madagasacar.
- Due to COVID19 our scheduled trips to Madagascar did not happen and are planned for 2022.
- The pick-up truck didn't have maintenance for a long time and above that the car was part of an accident which caused us to raise funds for maintenance and repair.
- Due to family expansion extra medical costs were covered.
- The number of student of the school in Tana is increasing fast. The building is too small to adequately house all the students. We are looking with them to buy a property and plans and budgets are made to build a new school. And as team are looking for ways to get sponsors and find funds for this project.
- Connections are made with churches in The Netherlands and England for joint actions.

**D. Time spend on this project**

With our team of five persons we spent in a year approximately the hours below on the following activities:

- Meetings and accompanying activities: 120 hours
- Keep track of finances and transfers: 40 hours
- Presentations 25 hours
- Preparation sponsorship school children 40 hours
- Recruiting sponsors project car 30 hours

E. Impact:

Our fund and support raising give the missionaries the opportunity to spend more time on their calling.

Bibles, basic medical treatment, schooling and different age group events are ways for the missionaries to spread the Good News among those that are not reached. Field trips to unreached people groups in joint venture with Heli Missions have great impact in spreading the gospel.

Bibles are spread in the native language Malagasy instead of French. Church planters are teaching young and old to read the Bible for themselves.

The school continues to expand, allowing more and more children to attend. This also means that they hear the gospel and that parents come in contact with it. There is a focus in all of this to educate the poorest children whose parents cannot afford to send their children to attend school.

At the moment we sponsor for 12 children.

The purchase of the car has increased the possibilities of transporting equipment, people, food and bibles in great number. For example, they now were able to deliver food packages to poor families in this time of COVID19.
